

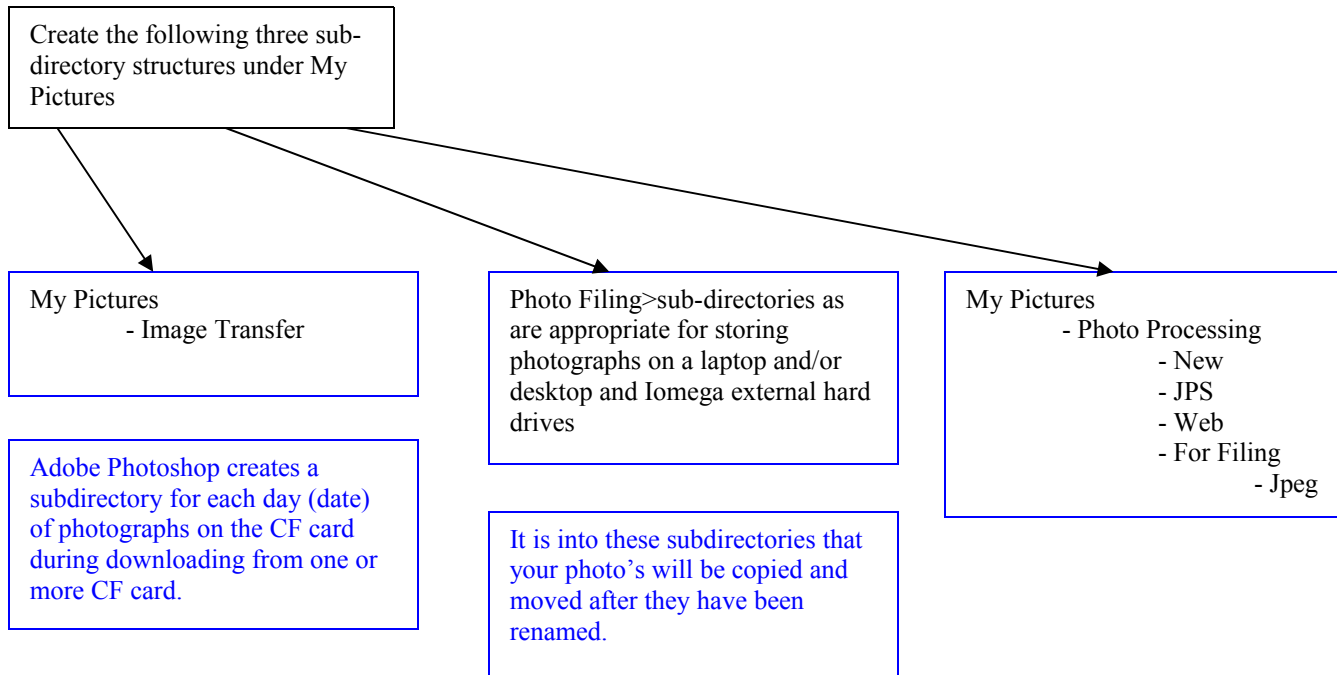

Using the Adobe Downloader transfer photo's from CF card to PC to the sub-directories My Pictures>Image Transfer>"date"

Format the CF card in the camera ready for use next time you go photographing

Edit using Breeze Browser Pro and delete all out of focus and other unusable photographs

Using Breeze Browser Pro rename all images according to the category in which they are to be filed and log them in the African Photographs Access Database

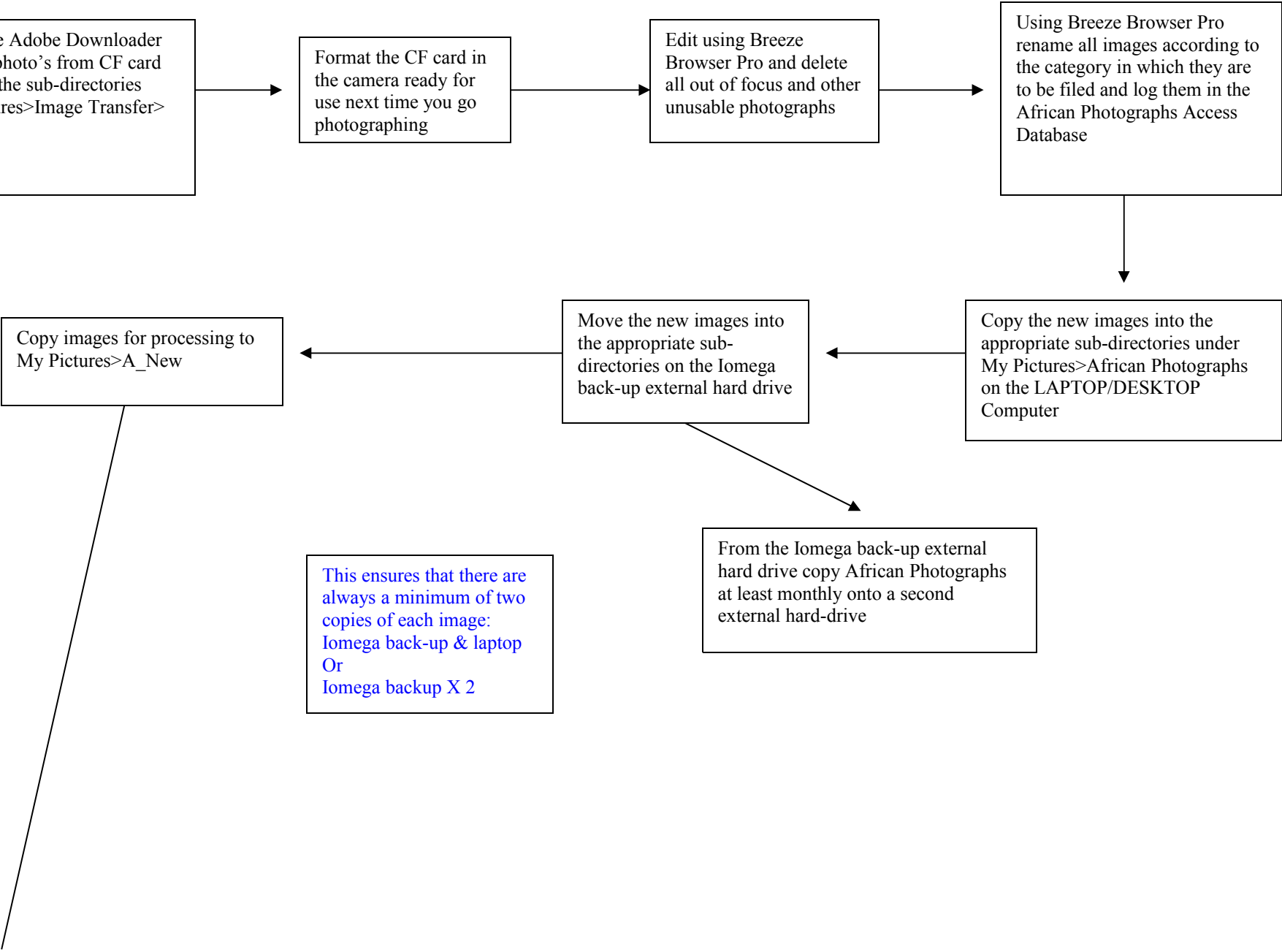
Copy the new images into the appropriate sub-directories under My Pictures>African Photographs on the LAPTOP/DESKTOP Computer

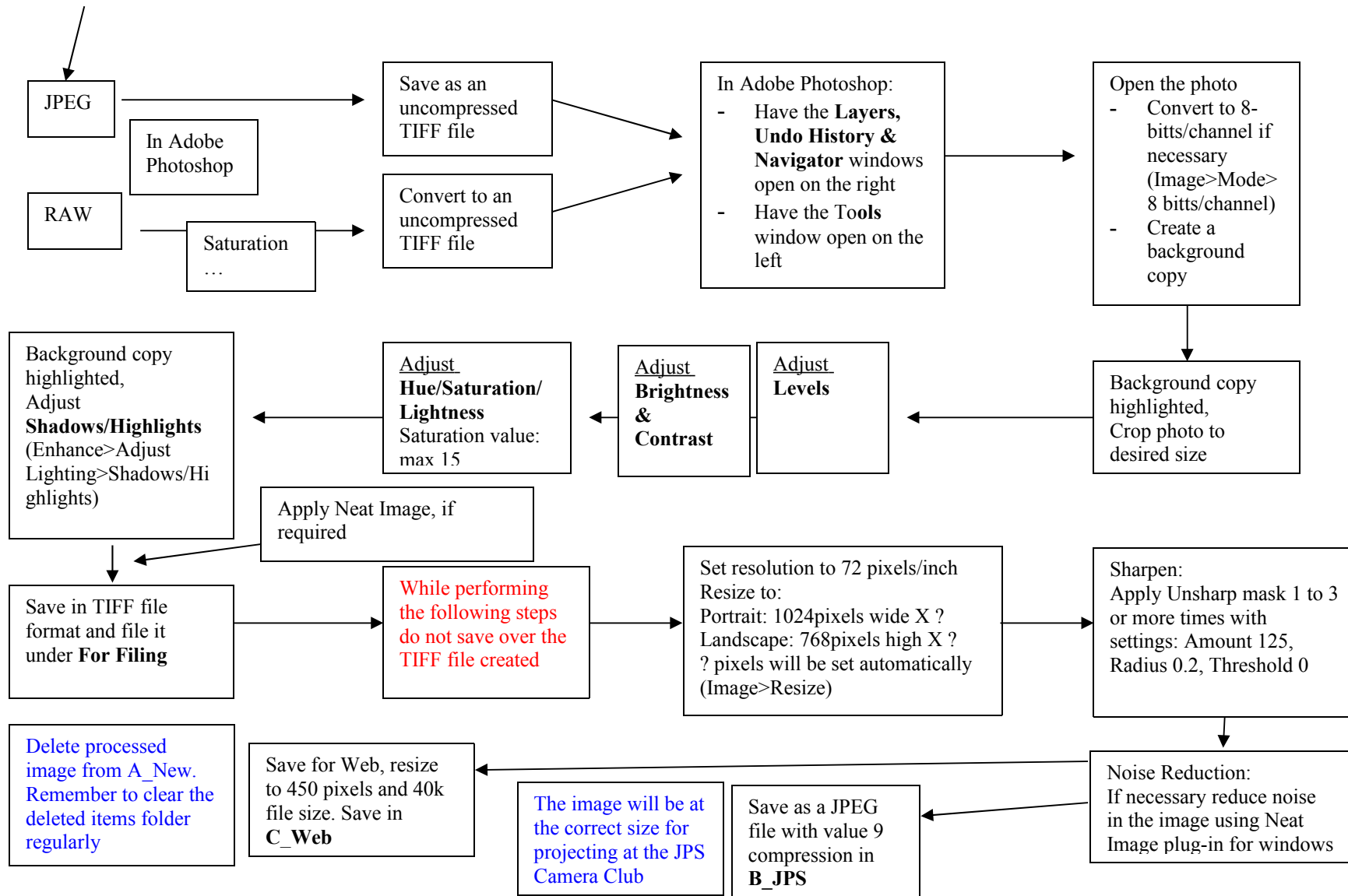
Move the new images into the appropriate sub-directories on the Iomega back-up external hard drive

Copy images for processing to My Pictures>A_New

This ensures that there are always a minimum of two copies of each image:
Iomega back-up & laptop
Or
Iomega backup X 2

From the Iomega back-up external hard drive copy African Photographs at least monthly onto a second external hard-drive
